Re: Sav-Rx - Medication for Erectile Dysfunction - Update

Recently the Board of Trustees adopted a change in the prescription drug benefit relative to the medication typically used to treat erectile dysfunction.

Currently the prescription drug benefit allows for 6 tablets per month for a diagnosis of Erectile Dysfunction (ED). The Federal Drug Administration (FDA) has recently expanded the indication for this medication from ED to include the treatment of Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia (BPH), a relatively common condition among men. The Board of Trustees elected to include this condition as an eligible condition for the prescription of ED medication.

At the retail pharmacy, you can purchase 6 tablets per month for ED and BPH conditions where the prescribing physician has indicated for Daily Use. If you purchase your medication by mail-order, you will receive 18 tablets for a three month supply. Medication for ED and BPH indicated for On Demand Use will require prior authorization from Sav-Rx.
